Enclosed, please find two items prepared by URS on behalf of Lehigh Southwest Cement Company (Lehigh)

- The revised Permanente Creek Long-Term Restoration Plan;
- A table listing the Lehigh responses to Board comments to previously submitted versions of the Permanente Creek Long-Term Restoration Plan.

Based on previous discussions with the Board, Lehigh understands that these submittals adequately address the Board's comments and concerns, and that the requirements of Item C-9, Phases 2 and 3 of the Order have been met. Further, Lehigh believes that all items of the Order, including Section C (Remedial and Long-Term Measures), Items I through 9, have been met, and that the Order should be rescinded.

Additionally, Lehigh agrees that a Sediment Source Study is intrinsic to the review, evaluation and modifications of Best Management Practices (BMPs), per the General Permit's mandated Storm Water Pollution and Prevention Plan (SWPPP).

Please note that the yellow highlighted areas throughout the Permanente Creek Long-Term Restoration Plan indicate areas that were changed from the previous submittal of March 10, 2010 based on comments received on September 8, 2010 from the Regional Water Quality Control Board.
